Designed for students interested in a teaching career, this pathway provides students an opportunity to develop skills in classroom management, lesson planning and instruction. Students summarize their knowledge and experiences in various classrooms from pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade in a professional portfolio. After completion of the Teaching Professions program requirements, students will be eligible to earn college credits at any Ohio university for an Introduction to Education course.
